Although quite capable of performing diverse musical styles, Inger has recently found his true voice and passion as a solo acoustic artist. His amazing sound is a blend of striking acoustic guitar playing, seductive vocals, and gorgeous melodies. Even though he has many musical influences, such as Jimi Hendrix, Eric Clapton, John Mayer, Sting, and Lenny Kravitz, Inger has definitely created his very own beautiful signature sound.

Famed pianist, composer, and artist Mike Garson (David Bowie) shared the stage with Inger for a performance of "Autumn Sunday Afternoon" where he described Inger as "a very talented singer-songwriter" (October 2006).

Inger is scheduled to perform at several venues and festivals in Holland and Germany in 2007. He will also perform in New York City ('Rockwood Music Hall', 'The Bitter End', 'The Baggot Inn' etc.) during the summer of 2007, as well as other areas along the East Coast of the United States.
